# STUDY GROUP 5 (1 KINGS 19:19-21 & 2 KINGS 2) "AS IRON SHARPENS IRON"

### **ELIJAH: STUDY GROUP 5 - SUMMARY OF MAIN POINTS**

This study is all about relationships. How they started, developed and ended. There are 3 parties involved God, Elijah and Elisha.

## Elijah and Elisha:

- Their first meeting: look at the attitude differences between Elijah and Elisha. E.g. Elijah throws his mantle over Elisha and walks off. Elisha hurrying to cut his former life off and minister/serve Elijah.
- 2 Kings 2v1-6: Elisha's care for Elijah in not leaving his side. Elijah wanting to do things himself.
- 2 Kings2v11-12: Elisha's view of Elijah, 'My father, my father!
- Elisha's grief when Elijah left him he rends his clothes, indicates the closeness between the two.

# God and Elijah:

 God through Elijah's ministry has tried to teach him to be a father figure then just a teacher (1 Cor.4v15). In this section he gives him a "son", Elisha.

## God and Elisha:

Showing to Elisha, that he was now to continue Elijah's work. With the sign of the chariot and horses
of fire.

Some other points to consider: Chariot of fire = the cherubim. 1 Chron.28v18; Ps.104v4; Ps.68v17; Ps.18v10.

## 1 Kings 19v19-21 Elijah meets Elisha

Elisha's total commitment to the work - severing all connection with his previous way of life

# 2 Kings 2v9 Elijah and Elisha leave Israel

v9 Double portion of the spirit – the right of the firstborn son. Elisha sees himself as Elijah's first born

# Elijah learns to be like God - to be a Father

## The Cherubim

Cherubim visions of **Ezekiel 1** & **Revelation 4** symbolise Christ and the saints God is working with all of us that we may become **YAHWEH**, that we might reflect His glory. This is the whole purpose of God (**Num 14v21**), to have a family who has character, and Divine Nature

Horsemen – See Rev 19v13-15. Christ and the saints are horsemen who destroy the Jezebel system.
